



# HOW TO REGISTER FOR QUIZZES AT BAKKAH.NET

1) Go to [www.bakkah.net/exams](http://www.bakkah.net/exams) - You should arrive at this screen:



2) Under the "Authentication" heading, click on the phrase: "Don't have a login? Create an account."


This should take you to the following screen:



3) Simply fill in the information in the six required fields (marked with a red '+' box). Be sure to spell your email correctly. Remember your username and password, as you will use them to sign in for the quizzes, in shaa' Allaah.

4) Review the terms and agreement on the next page of this PDF and then check the box next to "I agree to terms and agreements" and click "add".

You're done! You will be notified once your account is ready to use. Don't worry about the error message that appears:



## Terms and Agreements

All educational resources at Bakkah.net referred to as quizzes, tests, or exams are offered as free services to assist students in reviewing the material they have studied.

Registered students are required to use their real names upon registration. All information provided during registration must be factually true.

Copying them, forwarding them, or using them in any way beyond strict personal use without clearly written consent is not allowed.

When registering a new account, a registering student clicks "I agree to terms and agreements" to confirm the above as a binding agreement upon him- or herself, and Allaah is an All-Watcher over what we do.
