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All praise is due to Allah, the Lord, Creator, and Sustainer of all things. May He raise the rank of and grant peace to His Prophet and final Messenger, Muhammad, and all of his respected family and noble companions.

Allah, the Blessed and Exalted, has bestowed great blessings upon Mankind. From the greatest of those blessings is His guidance. He provides us with the most upright and wholesome religious beliefs and practice, including the most practical and beneficial guidelines for navigating this worldly life, and the most dignified and empowering ways of seeking the reward and forgiveness of the Most Merciful in the Hereafter and avoiding His punishment. This religion, Islam, has a Book and a Sunnah – a divinely revealed and preserved scripture along with authentically preserved narrations of Allah's last Prophet and Messenger, Muhammad (may Allah raise his rank and grant him peace), explaining that scripture and embodying how it is to be implemented.

﴿ لَقَدْمَنَ ٱللَّهُ عَلَى ٱلْمُؤْمِنِينَ إِذْ بَعَثَ فِيهِ مَرَسُولًا مِّنَ أَنَفُسِهِ مَ يَتَلُواْ عَلَيْهِ مَ اَلَتَهِ عَ وَيُزَحِيهِ مَرَوَيُعَالِمُ هُمُ ٱلْحِتَبَ وَٱلْحِكْمَةَ وَإِن كَانُواْ مِن قَبَلُ لَفِي ضَلَالٍ مَّبِينٍ ﴾

"Allah had indeed bestowed great favor upon the believers when He sent among them a Messenger from the their own selves, reciting His Verses to them, purifying them, and teaching them the Book and the *Hikmah* (wisdom, i.e. the Sunnah), after they had been in manifest misguidance before [that]." [3:164]

Allah, the Exalted and Lofty, inspired noble men and women among the Companions to preserve His guidance and pass it on, and then another generation of *Taabi'oon* (students of the Companions), then another and another, until this timeless message has reached us today, preserved letter for letter, in its original language, Arabic, a living language spoken by millions of people around the world, for all people of true intellect who seek piety and a noble path to success and salvation in the Hereafter Allah connects all of these aspirations to the Quran being revealed in the Arabic Language. Contemplate the following Verses:

﴿ إِنَّا أَنْزَلْنَهُ قُرْءَنَا عَرَبِيَّا لَعَلَّكُمْ تَعْقِلُونَ ﴾

"Indeed We have sent it down [as revelation], an <u>Arabic</u> Quran, in order for you to comprehend [using your intellect]." [12:2]

﴿قُرْءَانَا عَرَبِيًّا غَيْرَ ذِي عِوَجٍ لَعَلَّهُمْ يَتَّقُونَ ﴾

"An <u>Arabic</u> Quran, free of any crookedness, in order for you to attain piety." [39:28]

﴿وَكَذَلِكَ أَوْحَيْنَآ إِلَيْكَ قُرْءَانًا عَرَبِيَّا لِتُنذِرَ أُمَّ ٱلْقُرَىٰ وَمَنْ حَوْلَهَا وَتُنذِرَ يَوْمَ ٱلجَمَعِ لَارَيْبَ فِي فَوْيَقُ فِي ٱلجَنَّةِ وَفَرِيقٌ فِي ٱلسَّعِيرِ ﴾

"And thus We revealed to you an <u>Arabic</u> Quran, so you could warn [the people of] *Umm al-Quraa* (the center of all lands, i.e. Makkah) and all those around it (i.e. all of humanity), and so you could warn [them] about the Day of Gathering about which there is no doubt – one group will be in Paradise and another will be in the blazing Fire." [42:7]

While translations of the meanings of these texts have reached people of other languages and furnished them with some level of knowledge and benefit, these translations do not take the place of the actual texts of revelation in the Arabic Language. For this reason, the Arabic Language remains the most sought after language on the planet for over 1400 years, the key to understanding divine revelation, unlocking the potential of the human intellect and spirit, and paving the way to timeless righteousness and the most dignified ethics and morals ever sought by Mankind!

Arabic is not just letters and vocabulary; it is a rich and highly expressive language, having its own unique grammar, structure, and nuances of eloquence. Regarding the importance of one of its most important disciplines, *Nahw* (Arabic Grammar), our teacher, the great scholar, **Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al-'Uthaymeen** (may Allah have Mercy on him) stated that it is a noble field of study, one absolutely necessary in order to gain understanding of the Quran and the Sunnah.¹

Like all fields of study, Arabic Grammar has its basics and foundations. This text, *al-Muqaddimah al-Aajurroomiyyah* (the Aajurroomiyyah Primer), is arguably the best and most widely studied introduction to this important subject. The great scholar, 'Allaamah 'Abdur-Rahmaan ibn Naasir as-Sa'dee (may Allah have Mercy on him) said, after stressing the importance of memorizing and/or mastering basic primers in Islamic fields of study, like this *Aajurroomiyyah* text in Grammar specifically:

...When a student memorizes the foundations, he gains complete mastery over their understanding, and then the [remaining] books of that field become easy for him, be they short [books] or larger ones. The one who neglects the foundations is deprived of arrival [at any significant level of understanding]. Anyone who is vigilant regarding these beneficial disciplines, seeking the assistance of Allah, shall be aided by Him and blessed in his knowledge. Yet, whoever seeks knowledge taking other than this beneficial approach (i.e. mastery of the basics of each field firstly) only wastes time and exhausts himself [without benefit], as is known from [people's] experiences and as is witnessed...²

After Allah had blessed us to complete the study of the *Aajurroomiyyah* Primer in Arabic Grammar and its explanation by **Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al-'Uthaymeen** (may Allah

have Mercy on him) with a small group of focused and dedicated students in the year 1439 (2018), a number of our vigilant brothers requested to study the same classic text at al-Masjid al-Awwal in Pittsburgh, hoping to advance their Arabic Language skills and better understand their Religion. This workbook was originally prepared for them. After some years, as we approached the end of our study, we wanted to set this helpful resource in place for others to access, asking Allah to provide benefit through this work.

Al-hamdu lillaah, we thank Allah for facilitating this project, one of the fruits of four years' work and cooperation, by the Permission of Allah, and I hope that the students of the course will find it very useful. It includes the text of the *Aajurroomiyyah* Primer, fully voweled, point-by-point divided into 88 lessons, with translation and a summary of the key points and terms, followed by a chain of transmission for the text, quizzes for each of the lessons, final exams, answer keys, as well as the full uninterrupted (unvoweled) text of *Aajurroomiyyah*, and even a complete manuscript of the text. The **Personal Progress Tracker** on pages 9-10 can aid the student in navigating all these resources and using them to maximize the potential benefit of this study.

Like our other workbooks, this resource is designed to be studied under a teacher. **This is how Islamic knowledge is acquired**, under the direct instruction of competent and capable instructors, whenever possible.³ In the absence of this ideal scenario, one might fear Allah to the best of his ability by benefitting from an online course or recorded lessons, like the ones we have set up to go along with the resources in this workbook. 
